AN EXTENDED OFFER – YARNS AND FIBRES, KNITWEAR MANUFACTURERS AND DESIGN OFFICES

THE SECOND SPINEXPO™ PARIS WAS HELD IN PARIS FROM THE 3RD TO 5TH JULY 2017 AT THE NEWLY RENOVATED CITÉ DE LA MODE ET DU DESIGN, HOSTING 85 COMPANIES, COMPRISED OF 50 SPINNERS AND 33 KNITWEAR MANUFACTURERS, MAKING A TOTAL ATTENDANCE OF 688 VISITORS FROM 373 COMPANIES. THIS REPRESENTS SPINEXPO'S™ TARGET OF A HIGH QUALITY AND SUSTAINABLE INCREASE FROM THE PREVIOUS YEARS 610 VISITORS REPRESENTING 321 COMPANIES.



Responding to visitor and exhibitor feedback, SPINEXPO™ PARIS was extended to three days and opened its doors on a Monday, to better accommodate and maximise time for leading US buyers stopping in Paris to attend Fashion Week. This enabled SPINEXPO™ to welcome 20 visitors in total from the USA and Canada, representing a wide variety of leading brands from both market areas.

Despite the increased opportunity provided by opening on a Monday, this did place pressure on Sourcing Managers and weekly retail review meetings. SPINEXPO™ is reviewing feedback in this area to decide whether this should continue in future sessions or adjust its timing.

France still leads in visiting numbers, but the number of French brands visiting had decreased. The United Kingdom remained stable with Germany, the Netherlands and Turkey increasing their visitor numbers. Despite many brands pre-registering, their late ordering for the previous season has created human resource strains that prevented them from attending the show. This seems to have been a

The characteristic of the Paris show is to have a limited number of buyers per brand and is the explanation why the number of companies is high compared to the global number of visitors.
