


# **INSPIRATION**






# PROTECTIVE PADDING

Shock absorbing yarns and stitches protect us from the elements outside, with spongy aspects and padded details. Geometric padding is inspired from authentic sports equipment, with clever placements and patches allowing designers to play with new proportions and silhouettes.









# NETBALL

The various incarnations of netting used in sports, from badminton to basketball hoops, introduce a new interpretation of webbed structures. Yarns with waxed and synthetic aspects add to the lightweight and versatile uses of this direction as it is embraced by both mens and womenswear.







## LINEDRIVE

Linear graphics becomes subversive and complex as striped constructions embrace a mesh effect while maintaining a solid base. Architectural innovation becomes a source of key direction for crafting new looks for this upbeat and nautical direction.













# WATERSPORT

Innovative finishes look to impermeable waxes and treatments for a slick and glossy effect, creating high-definition contrast when combined with soft and spongy towelling. Dynamic textures are added via mesh stitches and small tuck stitches that are finely tipped for a graphic pop.









# RIPPLE EFFECT

Faint surface ripples are engineered into the structures of spring knitwear to allow for breathability and comfort, while allowing new interpretations of volume and leading the evolution in silhouettes. Delicately contrasting threads add a shirred or pleated effect for a handmade touch.


