YSK therefore presents the key products for the coming season:

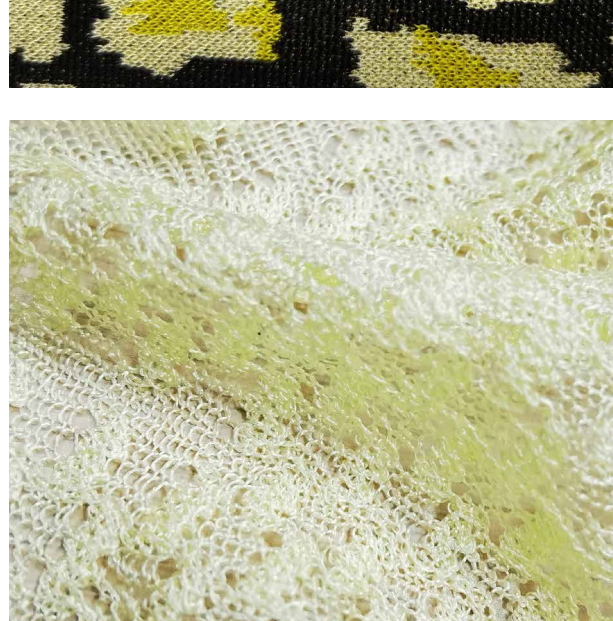
1. EXCEED-R 1/60 NM 100% RECYCLE POLYESTER

2. PATTY-29 1/29 NM 50% PAPER 50% POLYESTER

The paper is imported directly from Japan and is made from Manila hemp pulp which offers a high purity of cellulose. The paper is made by unique Japanese machines, used to produce a regular, light and strong base paper. It is a perfect raw material for creating a unique artistic texture and a natural sense of colour.

3. FULLY 1/37 NM 83% CUPRO 17% NYLON

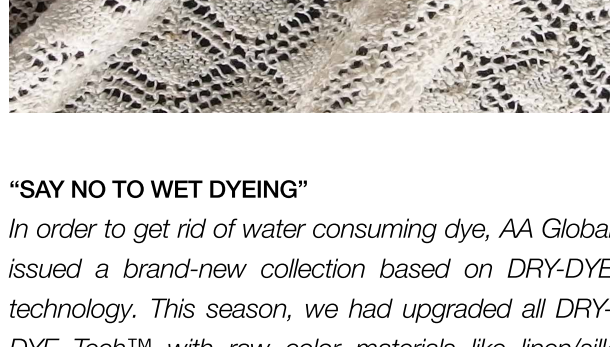

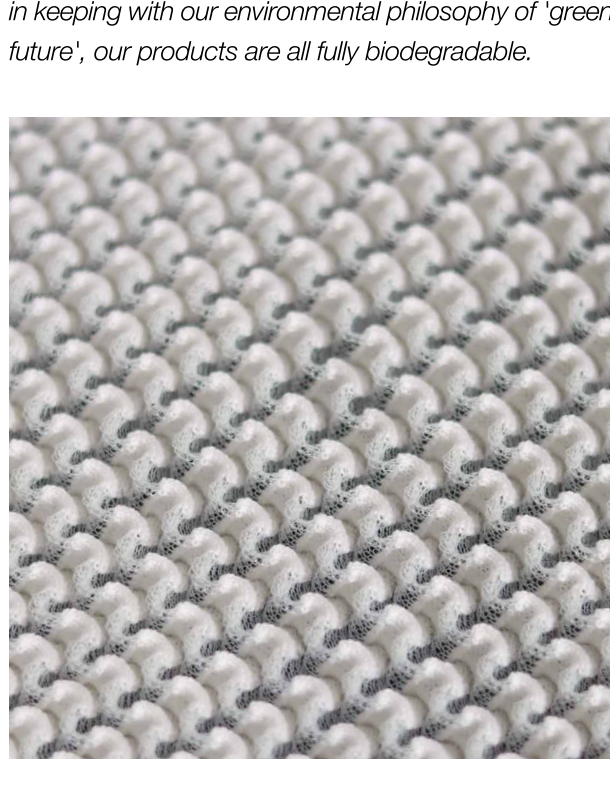
